

Life Group Questions For Discussion

Use any or as many of these questions as will be helpful for your discussion.

- What has been your favorite part of the Acts study so far?
- Read through Acts 3:11-26. List and discuss all the things that God has done
- List and discuss all the things that the passage says men have done. What does that reveal about the movement of God and man in salvation history?
- Look closely at Acts 3:19-21.
 - What does it really mean that, “sins may be wiped away”? See Psalm 51:7-9 and Colossians 2:13-15.
 - There are 3 “so that” statements in verses 19-20. List what they are, what previous statement they support, and why they are significant. What does it all mean?
 - What do you suppose the “times of refreshing” is all about? Based on what?
- Look closely at Acts 3:22-24. Read Deuteronomy 18:15-19. Based on Peter’s sermon, how would you respond to someone who believes Moses is referring only to Joshua?
- Based on Peter’s sermon, had the Jews all repented as he instructed, do you think the *earthly* Kingdom of God would have begun then & there? Why or why not?
- Why do you think we as believers still instinctively run *from* God when we sin?
 - What does that say about us?
 - What does God actually want us to do? What does that say about Him?
- Reread Acts 3:26. What did God do and why did He do it? Was that mission accomplished? Why or why not, and why does that matter?
